Eligibility


- Enrolled as the Master students that have the 1+1 articulation arrangement with UQ Faculty of Business, Economics and Law programs.



Entry Requirements

Commencement

Semester 1 (February) or Semester 2 (July) each year

Academic Entry Requirements 1+1 into UQ BEL Faculty's 1.5 year Master programs

- Successfully completed bachelor degree in the same discipline with an average grade of at least of 70% (60% is a pass);
- Successfully completed a minimum 1 year of study in the MBA or other recognized program at the College of Business Management at Tamkang University with a passing average grade or above

Field of study

 For students who have previously undertaken studies in business or commerce, entry will only be considered for a field **not already studied** (some exceptions may apply to accounting).





English Language

IELTS:

- Overall Band Score: 6.5
- Writing, reading, speaking and listening: 6

TOEFL:

- Internet-Based-iBT Overall Score: 87
- Writing score: 21
- Reading, speaking and listening: 19

Bridging English (BE) 15 weeks:

• IELTS 6.0 overall, no score less than 5.5 in each component (Dates for Semester 2, 2020 (July) degree: 15-weeks BE Advantage (recommended) with **BEP Extension** 17 February - 13 July 2020, BEP Extension offers an opportunity to re-sit BEP assessment if failing the first one)


