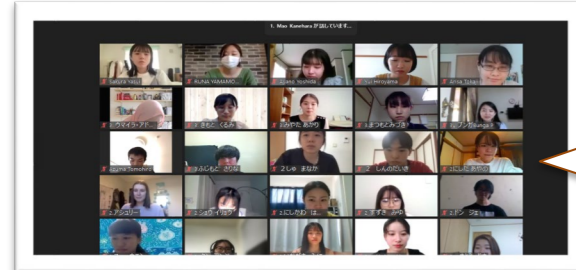

(3 Weeks)

Program Objective: Improve Japanese language proficiency while simultaneously increasing the level of understanding of Japanese society and culture.

◆<sup>じゅぎょうないよう</sup>授業内容

日本の<sup>てんとうぶんか</sup>伝統文化を1~2つとりあげ、それについて<sup>こうぎ</sup>講義、<sup>ちようさ</sup>調査、<sup>たいけん</sup>体験を行う。2022年<sup>ねん</sup>夏季の  
テーマは<sup>けんとうちゆう</sup>検討中である。

<sup>こうぎ</sup>講義では<sup>きょうし</sup>教師がテーマに<sup>かん</sup>関する<sup>きそてき</sup>基礎的な<sup>じようほう</sup>情報を<sup>しょうかい</sup>紹介する。<sup>ちようさ</sup>調査では<sup>がくせい</sup>学生はスモールグループとなり、<sup>あた</sup>与えられたテーマの<sup>ちようさ</sup>調査とクラスでの<sup>ほうこくはつびよう</sup>報告発表を行う。<sup>たいけん</sup>体験では、テーマに<sup>かんれん</sup>関連する<sup>せんもんしよくにん</sup>専門職人に<sup>はなし</sup>話を聞いたり<sup>げんば</sup>現場や<sup>じつぶつ</sup>実物の<sup>えいぞう</sup>映像を<sup>しちよう</sup>視聴したりし、<sup>じったいけん</sup>実体験に<sup>ちか</sup>近い<sup>かんかく</sup>感覚を  
味わう。<sup>さいご</sup>最後には<sup>じゅぎょう</sup>授業のまとめと<sup>こじん</sup>個人の<sup>おこな</sup>ふりかえりを行って<sup>さくせい</sup>レポートを作成し、<sup>がくしゅう</sup>学習した  
<sup>てんとうぶんか</sup>伝統文化の<sup>とうせい</sup>特性を<sup>しぶん</sup>自分の<sup>ことば</sup>言葉で<sup>せつめい</sup>説明する。

#### Outline

One or two traditional Japanese culture topics will be covered through lectures. Students will do some research, and some hands-on experiences on the topics.

The theme for the summer of 2022 is TBA.

In the lecture, basic information about the theme will be introduced by the lecturer. Students will work in small groups to do research on the given theme and do the presentation in the class. During the hands-on experience sessions, students would have the opportunity to talk to the professionals, or the Masters related to the theme and virtually experience the

sites and objects. At the end of the course, students will write a report in Japanese they have acquired. The report should cover the summary of the class, reflection on their individual experiences, and explain the characteristics of the traditional culture they have learned.
